

The TOC H New Zealand - Bowerbank Charitable Trust.

Information Sheet

The Toc H New Zealand – Bowerbank Charitable Trust was established by a Deed in March 1992. The trust is a perpetual trust where Public Trust as trustee is given the objective and the discretion to use the trust funds income towards charitable purposes in New Zealand with special consideration given to:

- Organisations and activities that support and promote the welfare of youth in all fields of endeavour, including sport;
- Organisations that support and promote the welfare of underprivileged persons in all age groups (but with preference being given to young persons) in all fields of endeavour, including sport.

The Trustee invites organisations, nominated by members of the Trust Board, to apply for funding. Grants are to be for a specific programme or activity, rather than general operating expenses.

Applications will need to include:

- Latest set of audited or reviewed accounts.
- Supporting information such as proposal, budget for the year, copy of quotes etc.
- Your organisations bank account for payment of a successful grant. Also, if your bank account has changed since your last grant from the Toc H New Zealand Bowerbank Charitable Trust.

Closing Date

Please fully complete the application form and submit along with supporting documents, to Public Trust at <u>funding@publictrust.co.nz</u> by **31 July.** It is important that details on the form be concise and easy to read.

The Trust Board will make a decision as to the grants and the Trustee will notify all applicants on the outcomes.

General

Decisions regarding grants are made on the basis of information provided in the application and other enquiries. The information provided by your organisation becomes the property of the Toc H New Zealand – Bowerbank Charitable Trust and may be made available to other parties in the course of enquiries regarding applications or in publishing the results of grants approved.

Terms and conditions

- Grants are given at the discretion of the Board. There are no guarantees that applicants who have previously received a grant will receive further grants.
- The Toc H New Zealand Bowerbank Trust, and the grant amount, is to be acknowledged in the recipients' annual accounts and/or annual report.
- Any unspent portion of the grant belongs to the trust and must be returned.
- While it is not compulsory for an organisation to be registered on the Charities Register, the organisation must have a charitable purpose.
- Once a successful applicant has received the grant, they must forward confirmation of receipt to the trustees as soon as possible.
- For any grants totalling \$25,000 or more, the trustees may request, at any time from the recipient, reports on the project and application of funds.
- Where the grant has been provided in respect of a project, the project must be completed within 12 months from receipt of the grant. On completion of the project, a report of less than two pages must be sent to the trustees in electronic form. It should include the proposed and actual budget and contain:
 - the number of people who benefited;
 - a brief description on how they benefited;
 - what worked and what did not.
